



Permission to Travel Form for Minors

PERMISSION TO ENTER FOREIGN COUNTRY FOR MINORS (under age 18)

Minors under the age of 18 traveling from Canada to any foreign destination, when not accompanied on the trip by parents, must have a notarized affidavit from the parent(s) not accompanying the child that:

- The child is traveling out of Canada with the permission of the parent(s).
- The child is travelling under the supervision of the GSSC STAFF and

Glen Shields S.C. is asking all minors to have parents sign 1 permission form, which must be notarized and provide the original to the coaching staff.

1. If Minor is travelling alone, then both parents must sign consent form.
2. If one parent is travelling with the minor, the other parent must sign for consent.
3. If one parent is the custodial parent, there **MUST** be legal proof/documentation of this status.
